

Recordation Fee Revenue Amendments

- Provides the recordation fee proceeds dedicated to the implementation of agricultural best management practices
- \$10 million in non-general funds appropriated in each year
- For FY20, increases amount of technical assistance provided
 - \$8.7 million for agricultural BMPs
 - \$1.3 million for technical assistance to Districts each year



NOTE: FY19 actual revenue includes revenue received as of December 31, 2018.



Anticipated Results

- Achieves compliance with Virginia's Chesapeake Bay TMDL water quality goals (WIP III)
- Fulfills Virginia's commitment to agricultural producers who signed up for livestock exclusion practices in 2015
- Increase stream and river buffers throughout the state
- Expand existing poultry litter transport program to include Eastern Shore
- Increase development and implementation of RMPs, encouraging voluntary BMP implementation
- Provides overarching natural resource and environment benefits for Virginia



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
